What do we need for finger plays?

- Only body and voice
- Felt board and felt pieces.
- Craft foam
- Props/images
- Puppet/glove
- Finger play cards or popsickle sticks or cube

5 Silly Clowns

Five silly clowns, jumping all around. (Move arm with five fingers up and down.) Jump so high, then touch the ground! (Move arm up in air; then down to the floor). One silly clown says, "I can't stay," (Remove one clown from board; shake head "no.") So he turns and (fill in action) away! (Put clown aside or in pocket.)

Way up high in the apple tree

Way up high in the apple tree, (Point up high) Two little apples smiled at me. (make two circles with hands) I shook that tree as hard as I could, (Pretend to shake the tree with both hands) And down came the apples, (Wiggle fingers down from the air) Mmmm, they were good! (Rub tummy!)

(Change the fruit or turn it into a silly rhyme)

This is my turtle. (Make fist, extend thumb) He lives in a shell. (Hide thumb in fist) He likes his home very well. (nod) He pokes his head out (Pop thumb out of fist) when he wants to eat. (circle thumb around) And pulls it back in when he wants to sleep. (Pull thumb back into fist)

Sharks in the bathtub

One shark in the bathtub going for a swim. ("Fin" with hands on head) Knock, knock (clap hands twice) Splash, splash (slap your knees twice) Come on in! (wave to enter with both hands)

(Repeat with two sharks, three sharks, four sharks...)

Five sharks ... They all fall in! (knock everything off of the board!)

(Have children to be the sharks and invite their friends into the bathtub)

Three Bubbles

Here's a little bubble. (Make a small circle with your thumb and index finger.) And here's a bigger bubble. (Make a bigger circle using both thumbs and both index fingers.) And a great big bubble I see. (Make a large circel by holding your arms up over your head) Shall we count them? Are you ready? One, two, three! (Count to three with your fingers or make 3 circles again) POP! (clap hands loudly once)

Clap Your Hands

Clap, clap, clap your hands As slowly as you can. (say is slowly) Clap, clap, clap your hands As quickly as you can.(say it fast)
