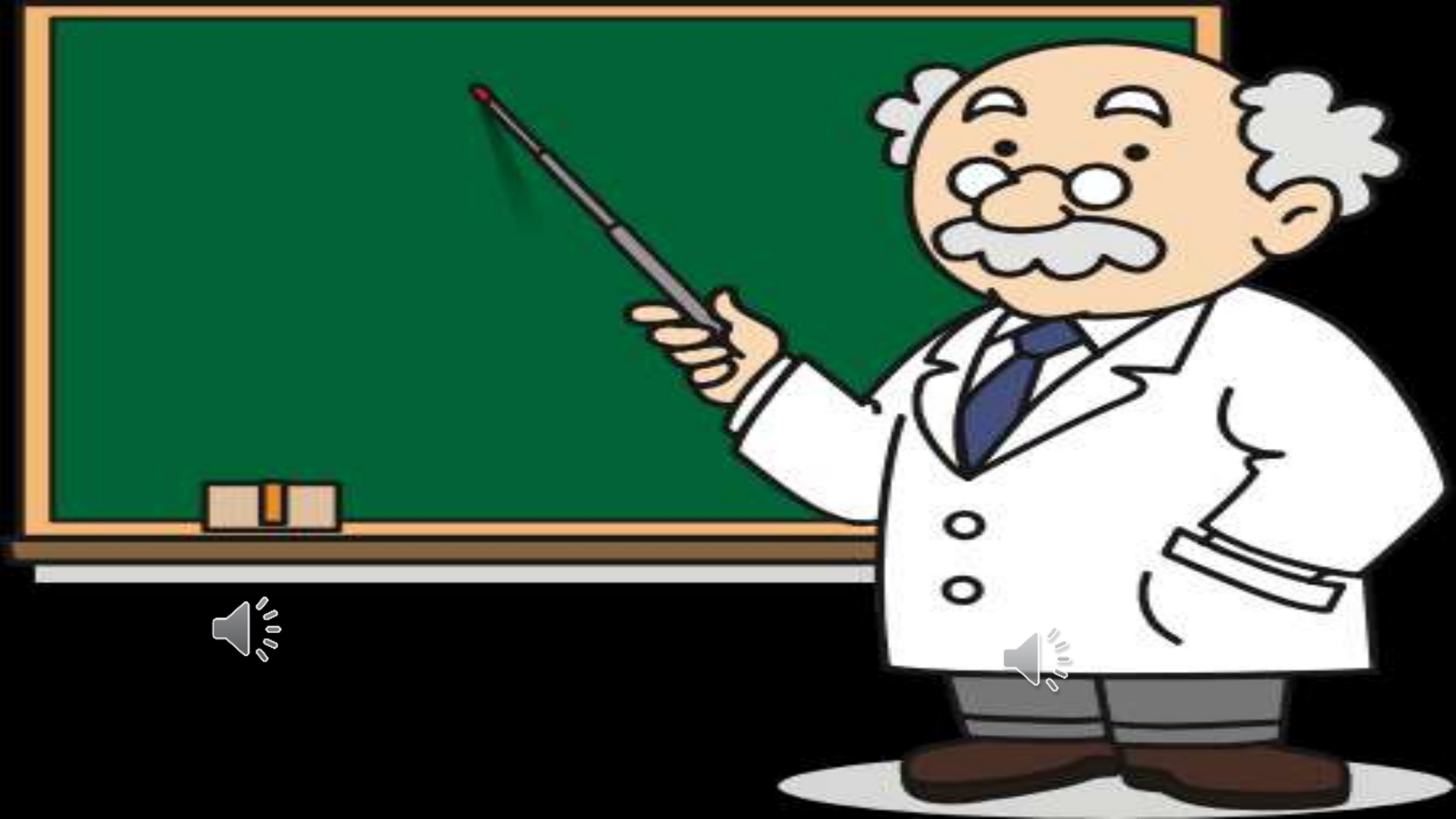

TEACHING LISTENING OR TESTING LISTENING?

- Asking questions after a listening task is a testing technique and not a teaching technique
- The classroom methods that most teachers think of as tools for teaching listening comprehension in fact amount to a form of continuous testing
- Teachers should use listening exercises as a framework for assisting students to understand spoken language

pedo *m* **2** (fam o, para algunas pers, vulg) (borrachera): **me agarré un ~ tremendo** I got shit-faced bigtime (vulg); **estar/ponerse en ~** to be/get plastered (colloq) o sloshed (colloq) o wasted (colloq) o tanked (colloq) o hammered (colloq) o trashed (colloq) o fucked-up (vulg); **estás en ~ si pensás que te va a llamar** you're high (hum) o smoking crack (hum) if you think she's going to call you; **ni en ~** (fam): **no te digo mi contraseña ni en ~** there's no way o no chance in hell (colloq) I'm telling you my password; **¿vas a ir? — ¡ni en ~!** are you going to go? — hell, no! (colloq) o no way! (colloq) o not a chance!; **ser del año del ~** (fam) ⇒ **año: el año del jopo** or **del pedo**; **tener un ~ en la cabeza** (fam) (tener ideas ridículas) to be messed up o (colloq) whacked (colloq) o fucked up (vulg) in the head
