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








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Seating arrangement



Using an illustrated book in Story Time

- · Tell the story showing the pictures
- · Decide what the focus is.
- Fold the book/ put the book away at times if necessary.
- · Use the book to create suspense.
- Involve your listeners actively

Active listeners

- · Tell the story WITH your audience.
- Active listeners SAY
- Active listeners DO



 You may rehearse audience participation


