- Many games require movement, which has been proved to be highly effective for the learning process.
- Games are fun! Neuroscientists have put forward the eloquent idea that
 positive emotions during learning create a great association in the
 brain, providing a powerful boost for learning.
- Many games help develop higher order functions such as working memory, decision making, logical thinking and adequate management of emotions.
